P.E. in the National Curriculum

We would like to remind you that P.E. is an important part of the National Curriculum, and we are keen that all pupils participate in their two P.E. lessons each week. In order to do this, each child needs to have a P.E. kit in school (both indoor and outdoor), and we suggest that as this is only worn for a maximum of two hours a week, it does not need to go home after every week, but could be washed during the half term and main holidays.

If your child is in school, then we expect that they are well enough to participate in P.E. lessons. If your child has a valid reason to miss P.E. – for example a sprained ankle or a painful back – then this needs to be explained in a note to the teacher. If we do not have this note, we may well insist on your child participating in the planned lesson.

Sainsbury's Active Kids Vouchers

Sainsbury's are helping schools to collect vouchers which can be used to buy sports and play equipment for the school. We make good use of this opportunity to improve our provision and resources even further, and would encourage you to collect the vouchers if ever you – or family, friends, or neighbours - shop at Sainsbury's stores, and bring them into school.

Holly Park Expansion Update

I am sure that like me you are aware that it's all gone a bit quiet on the proposed expansion front. I am liaising with Barnet council and they have told me that before proceeding to the next steps at Holly Park, the Council is reviewing again all options within the area to provide additional school places. This review will take into account all views that have been expressed concerning the proposed expansion.

I can tell you that only 60 places have been offered out for next year's Reception, and we have 55 children on our waiting list. As yet there has been no request for us to take an additional class next year.

Some Improvements for Next Year

The budget for the new financial year was ratified by the governors shortly before the Easter holidays. I am pleased to share with you some of the planned improvements which we were able to include in it:

- We will be redecorating the Nursery, the Dining Hall and the Main Hall over the Summer holidays
- We will be replacing the surface of the Ball Area with Astroturf, and raising the height of the netting which forms its roof
- In early May we will be replacing the water fountains which seize up every winter with new ones which will work all year round
- The toilets outside Chestnut and Elm classes and the disabled toilet will be fully refurbished
- We are investing £13,000 in additional ICT resources, in addition to our four laptop trolleys
- We are investing £5,000 in equipment for the Early Years, particularly for the outdoor area
- We are creating three new teaching roles to support interventions for children of all abilities as well as covering the teachers' Planning, Preparation and Assessment time.
