Percy Llewellyn Evan

Last week in the remembrance assembly we talked about **Percy Llewellyn Evans** who was a Sergeant, 14th Battalion, Middlesex Regiment, who died on 12th February 1917 on home service, aged 30 after he caught a disease in the trenches. He was buried in Friern Barnet Churchyard. Percy was a teacher at Holly Park School. At the weekend both Mrs Casey and I went to find his grave. Mrs Casey left poppy decorated stones. We were intrigued to see that someone (perhaps a relative) had put a cross by the grave.



Anti- Bullying Week

As part of Anti bullying week we asked all of the children to come to school wearing odd socks. The idea is meant to be fun BUT also is an opportunity for children to express themselves as individuals and to recognise that it is ok for us all to be different. The children had an assembly about bullying where they have learnt to be an “Upstander” not a “Bystander”. In class the children made “face mash ups”, to celebrate our differences and diversity. They also drew around their hand and on each finger they wrote down who they would talk to if they were being bullied. Children in KS2 also had a lesson about online Bullying.



Parent Consultation

The parent consultations for Y1 to Y5 (Juniper) take place in the main school hall. The meetings for Y5 Maple and Y6 are in the shared area outside their classrooms. Each teacher will be sitting at a desk. If you arrive earlier than your timed slot, then please go into the hall as there will be seats available for you to wait for your consultation. It will also mean that the teacher can see that you have arrived. Each consultation slot is for 10 minutes. The norm in most primary schools is 5-10 minutes. The teachers will try their best to keep to time and we would ask that you please arrive in time for your slot. If you do arrive late, it may be that your consultation has to be moved back a bit and you will have to wait a bit. Please be patient if at the end of a long session of parent meetings the teacher is running a bit late for your meeting.

If you and the teacher feel that at the end of 10 minutes there is more time needed to discuss your child then you can of course make another time after school one day if necessary and with the agreement of the teacher.

We do ask that **all children** come to the consultation meetings and are part of the discussions. This is a system that we have used now for many years. We believe that it is very important that the children are part of the discussions and hear what is being said about them. Again we would ask that while you are waiting for your appointment that the children sit quietly and are not running around the hall, climbing on to the stage or banging the African drums. These first consultations will tell you about how your child has settled into Y1 academically, socially and emotionally and how they seem to be progressing at this early stage. The teacher will point out any early areas where the child might need consolidation and further practice and support. They will also point out areas where the child may be excelling. It is also an opportunity for you to ask any questions. The second consultation in February/March time will be more about the progress they are making and areas that they need more consolidation and help with as that will be the midpoint of the school year.
