

<p>Date: 7/7/20</p>	<p>Morning everybody, we hope you are well. Are you co-operating at home and helping each other? Remember, Team Work makes the Dream Work! Here are the activities for the day:</p>
<p>Reading:</p>	<p>Open the power point of The Coral Kingdom and read the story. <i>How does the author describe the polyps? What was the dugong doing? How would you describe this interesting sea creature? Where can the coral reef be seen from? What do you think the author means by 'every creature plays its part?'</i></p>
<p>Writing</p>	<p>We are going to start putting together a fact file based on a chosen sea creature of your chose. You need to choose one that makes you smile or wonder about it. It could be an octopus or a crab or any of the other sea creatures in the book. Once you have chosen one, please draw it on the sheet attached and label it carefully. What is the lightest you can find? Always ask to use the scales and don't break them by putting really heavy objects on them!!</p>

Handwriting	<p>We have covered all of the handwriting joins for Year 2 so now we will start recapping them. Today we will practise the oo and oa join. Do you remember the warm-up routines? Have a go at warming up your hands and arms. Now practise these joins by copying the work from today's hand writing page using your best handwriting.</p>
Spelling:	<p>Use one of our spelling strategies to learn these words: floor and poor</p> <p>You could try speed-writing, pyramid words, bubble writing, underlining the vowels or rainbow writing your letters etc. Use look, cover, write and check to test if you remember them! After you have had a chance to practise, get someone to read the 3 words to you and see if you can spell them all correctly!</p>
