<p>Reading:</p>	<p>Read the story of The Coral Kingdom from the video, Can you remember what those tricky words mean? Have a look at the colours in the story. <i>What colours does the author use to describe the coral and the sea creatures? What do the garden eels do? How do the mantas move? How do the turtles move? What does it mean when it says 'living jewels that must not fade?' What are the living jewels?</i></p>
<p>Writing</p>	<p>Have a look at the last page on the Coral Kingdom video. You are going to find out some more facts on your chosen sea-creature. Use the sheet attached and research your chosen creature. Remember to add 'kids' at the end of your Google search when you hunting for facts! Can you find out 8 facts about your chosen creature? <i>Where do they live? What do they eat? How do they defend themselves? How do they survive? How big do they grow?</i></p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Watch the <u>Summer term week 10 commencing 22nd June</u>, lesson 2 video called Measure Mass in Kilograms. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Complete the worksheet attached. Do you have bathroom scales in your house? Can you find something that</p>



	<p>weighs more than 1kg? How much does your favourite toy weigh? Can you find objects that weigh more than 2kg? What is the heaviest toy you own? Draw a picture of it and label the weight of it? Did you have to use the bathroom scales for it or the kitchen scales? Have a think why we use the bathroom ones for heavier items.</p>
Handwriting	<p>We have covered all of the handwriting joins for Year 2 so now we will start recapping them. Today we will practise the wa and wo join. Do you remember the warm-up routines? Have a go at warming up your hands and arms. Now practise these joins by copying the work from today's hand writing page using your best handwriting.</p>
Spelling:	<p>Use one of our spelling strategies to learn these words: <i>pass and plant.</i></p> <p>You could try speed-writing, pyramid words, bubble writing, underlining the vowels or rainbow writing your letters etc. Use look, cover, write and check to test if you remember them!</p> <p>After you have had a chance to practise, get someone to read the 3 words to you and see if you can spell them all correctly!</p> <div data-bbox="459 1178 753 1406" data-label="Image"> <p>The image shows four small cards with different spelling strategies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rainbow Write: First write each word in pencil. Then trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you must use a DIFFERENT color crayon. Trace neatly and you will see a rainbow! Silly Sentences: Write silly sentences using a spelling word in each sentence. Please underline your spelling words! Write neatly! Example: My dog <u>sa</u>rs a blue and <u>pl</u>nt dress when he takes a bath. Hidden Words: Draw and color a picture. Hide your spelling words inside your picture. Show your picture to someone and see if they can find your hidden words! Backwards Words: Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards. Write neatly! Example: <u>wh</u>ere <u>si</u>nke </div>
