Holly Park Ofsted Report

The official Ofsted report and an accompanying letter was emailed out to parents earlier this week. I hope that you enjoyed reading it and were as pleased with the outcome and comments as we were.

It is always a shame that the report is so short - however it has to follow a strict Ofsted prescribed format. We received a lot of detailed feedback during the inspection and at the end of each day which we were allowed to take note of and which I chose to share with you.

We were very pleased that the inspector found no areas that were negative or that needed significant work. We were delighted that there was only one point to consider about what we could do to improve and this was about some minor curriculum inconsistency. We will be considering this as part of our school improvement plan for September 2024 and the next academic year.

My favourite piece of feedback which was given at the end of inspection briefing to senior leaders, governors and the local authority and which was the inspectors summary of the school was:

'Holly Park is a school that doesn't stand still and is always striving to be the best it can be. Children's interests are at the heart of everything. The school has safe, happy children. The school is a warm, welcoming environment. The school provides a wellrounded education.'
