#### Uniform

We have noticed recently that uniform is not being followed correctly by several children and families.

After Easter we will be looking very closely at uniform and will be messaging daily to parents of children who are not wearing the correct Holly Park uniform.

#### Some reminders:

- For PE children must have plain white trainers.
- Navy blue trousers are not part of our uniform.
- Hair accessories should be in school colours
- No jewellery (except of a religious nature) should be worn

Here is the Holly Park summer uniform:

#### Year I to Year 6 Summer

As Winter or:

Green and white checked dress (optional and generic)

Grey shorts (generic)

White or black sandals with secure fastening (max heel height 3cm) NO Trainers or CROCS

A cap to protect from the sun

\*No other items of clothing should be visible under the red polo shirt. If a child is cold they should wear a short-sleeved vest and their sweatshirt on top,

#### PE Kit

Red shorts (generic)

Plain white T-shirt (generic or branded)

Plain white trainers

Outdoor kit of dark green jogging trousers and top

A reminder that our school summer dresses at Holly Park are green and white gingham - NOT red and white.
