Scooters In School

Y4 Multiplication Check 2025

The children in Year 4 will take part in the national multiplication test after half term. This is an annual assessment and is done as quick-fire multiplication questions online up to 12x12 where children have seconds to type in the answers. Mrs Thomas will administer the test with the Year 4 pupils. Year 4 parents will get the results later this term. It is a good idea for Year 4 parents and children to practice their times tables over the holiday. Times Table Rockstars is a great resource. To practice with at home.

YI Phonics Check 2025

The children in Year I will take part in the national phonics check after half term. This is an annual assessment for all Year I children across the country. Miss Richardson will carry out the checks. Year I parents will get the results later this term. It is a good idea for Year I parents to practice reading phonic words over the holiday with their children – both real words and alien words.

Y5 Secondary Transfer Information

There is a meeting for current Y5 parents on Monday 16th June at 9am about secondary transfer for their children and how the process works. This is now the start of a very important time for Y5 parents and children as they make decisions about the next educational step for their children.
