The PTA have had some really lovely jars and pots given in over the last two weeks, and have been keeping a tally to see which team will get the most house points.






Attendance Is Part Of Safeguarding

A reminder that the new statutory safeguarding and child protection guidance for schools in England has been updated with the decision that being absent from education can be a warning sign of a range of safeguarding concerns, including sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or child criminal exploitation.

Children who are absent from education_refers to children who are registered pupils at a school but not attending regularly. This includes persistently absent pupils (who are absent 10 percent or more of the time from school) or severely absent pupils (who are absent 50 percent or more of the time).

Schools are required to put in place appropriate safeguarding responses for pupils who become absent from education, particularly on repeat occasions and/or for prolonged periods. Children with attendance of 90% or less will need to be referred to the Barnet Educational Welfare Officer.



Parent workshop - Marking & Feedback

Marking and feedback is a crucial part of teaching and learning; it is how we assess pupils' understanding, decide on next steps, address misconceptions and celebrate their successes. Primary Maths Challenge

The Primary Maths Challenge (PMC) is a mathematical competition created by The Mathematical Association for primary school pupils in years 4 to 6, designed to encourage enthusiasm and logical reasoning rather than just formal curriculum knowledge. The challenge isn't easy and is designed for the most able mathematicians. Questions are designed to be logical and not heavily reliant on formal curriculum knowledge, encouraging students to think creatively. Certificates are given for participation, and gold, silver, and bronze certificates are awarded to top scorers in each school. A second, invite-only round is available for high-scoring students, which has a similar format to the main challenge but is designed to be more challenging. We await to hear who has been selected (If anyone) for entry into the next round. Huge congratulations to Franco who was the highest scoring pupil at Holly Park.
