At Holly Park we have a very wide range of children who have additional needs and receive extra support or adaptations in the classroom. This can range from health issues, hearing impairment, dyslexia, to complex needs. This includes children who have no official diagnosis to those who have an EHCP. We have over 70 children this could include. It will also be a chance to meet other SEND families. Mrs Kelly will be circulating whilst you have coffee and chat so there will be a chance to find out information about SEND at the school and ask any questions you have. We hope that it will help families form a community. We are excited to be hosting our first SEND coffee morning.
